## BIG SKY, MONTANA

*"The biggest skiing in America"*

**Saturday, February 8, 2020 to Saturday, February 15, 2020**

Chicagoland Club 50's western ski trip in 2020 will be to Big Sky, Montana from Saturday, February 8 to Saturday, February 15. Please join us for a great ski and après ski experience.

Big Sky is a huge area with 15% beginner, 25% intermediate, 42% advanced and 18% expert terrain. A lot of skiing for all levels: 36 lifts, 317 runs, the longest of which is 6 miles! They recently merged with Moonlight Basin and Spanish Peaks, making Big Sky the largest ski resort in North America! It is consistently recognized in national ski magazines for short or non-existent lift lines.

We will stay in the resort village at the Summit Hotel, which got rave reviews the last time Club 50 went to Big Sky in 2015. It's ski-in, ski-out so no tromping through town in ski boots! The hotel has a heated pool, hot tub, bar/lounge, restaurant and free internet. Hot breakfast is included each day.

The price of \$1855\*\* includes:

- 7 nights lodging in the Summit Hotel, two to a room with two queen beds
- Round-trip airfare on American Airlines non-stop Chicago-Bozeman
- Round-trip transfers from Bozeman to Big Sky
- Luggage handling
- Welcome reception
- Daily hot breakfast
- 5 wine and cheese parties
- Pizza party one evening
- Driver and hotel tips
- Trip insurance

5-day adult lift ticket is \$400; an additional day is \$100 if you purchase it when you sign up for the 5-day pass. Big Sky is on the Ikon Pass, which you may want to buy if you are skiing at other Ikon areas in 2020.

Look at the Big Sky resort website for a trail map. For those of you concerned, the map shows most of the area as green and blue runs. The black runs are concentrated on Lone Mountain, spectacular, but a separate peak.

Optional activities may include a guided snowmobile trek into Yellowstone National Park or a sleigh ride to dinner on the mountain. Lots of interesting restaurants on the mountains and in the village. Plan for a fun ski week!
